**CALL TO ORDER** by Chairman Gaskins

**INVOCATION** by Vice Chairman Hammond.

**PLEDGE** by Commissioner Johnson.

Chairman Gaskins introduced Ms. McGillicuddy, news reporter from the Daily Reflector. She stated it was her first day and hour on the job and hopes to give best coverage possible.

### **APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Mr. Robinson asked the Board to postpone the Martin Community Action appointment and that Mervis Joyner had requested the postponement of the Bell Arthur Water System item. Collice Moore had indicated that he was working on getting a feasibility study done on a bridge over the Tar River and asked for a resolution of support.

**UPON MOTION** by Commissioner Ward, seconded by Commissioner Shank, to approve the agenda as amended. The motion was unanimously approved.

### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**UPON MOTION** by Vice Chairman Hammond, seconded by Commissioner Bowen, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the February 7 and 21, 2000 Board meetings.

**PUBLIC ADDRESSES TO THE BOARD**

- ? Janet Bullock from the recovery center for families said they were addressing the needs of displaced families. She said they are representing several agencies, meeting in Sycamore Hill Baptist Church and have served over 1000 families providing food, clothing, shelter, money and other items. Workshops have been held at Phillipi Church. All support has been from donations and they are aggressively pursuing funds and she was asking Pitt County to partner with them so they can address more senior citizens and youth. They currently partner with the North Carolina Rural Economic, Z. Smith Reynolds and the Frank Johnson foundation
- ? Nancy Colville spoke in support of the Board having the workshop with Michael Crowell to address board size. She said that this county is divided and it is not working the way it is currently set up. She spoke about the black targeted programs that are not effective for all flood victims. She stated that the State and County should control flood programs. She stated that retired Commissioner Jeff Savage still has the computer he signed out from the County MIS Department. She said Eleanor Farr, Clerk of Superior Court, needs to go ahead and make an appointment to fill the District A seat. She said that the Board of Commissioners should not appoint any more elected officials to the PCMH Board of Trustees because Commissioner Bowen was appointed on the premise that he would report to the Board of Commissioners about the activities of the PCMH Board of Trustees but he has not been making reports. She said she was not picking on Ms. Barbara Fenner but that a lot of people were not getting their questions answered. There is not an active Chairman and that for the last three years she has not received the funds requested because of her products not meeting proper standards. She is in charge of a lot of funds for flood victims.
- ? Jane Barnhill, resides north of the river, said that some of the citizens have been having some meetings among themselves. She asked the Commissioners to have a meeting at night, at least once a quarter, so people who work could come and voice their concerns. She said she had been asked again about crop allotments on property that the County owns. She stated her support of the workshop with Michael Crowell and asked that the Board keep the public informed on the process so they feel included.
- ? Vernon Morrison, resides north of the river, spoke about the overtime pay for County employees that was turned in for the work during the flood. He stated he had a report for a month and a half of overtime pay and people on an annual salary should not be turning in overtime. He spoke about illegal aliens coming to the United States.

**PUBLIC HEARINGS ON INSTALLMENT FINANCING FOR SCHOOLS – Melonie Bryan**

Ms. Melonie Bryan explained the need to hold the public hearings and adopt the resolution on the School's financing package for \$23,000,000. She stated that they would go on the market in April but she did not know an actual date.

Chairman Gaskins announced that the public hearing was open.

Ms. Nancy Colville spoke about the public not having a clue about what the Board is doing with this public hearing and resolution. She said she was not opposed to what the Board was doing but the public hearing was being held late in the game and the public has not been educated on this item. She said this Board should have the schools' budget.

Chairman Gaskins asked if anyone else wished to speak. No one came forward. Chairman Gaskins announced the public hearing closed. Ms. Bryan said these projects have been going on for thirteen months and have been before the Board on several occasions. She said that this project will be followed up in the fall and they project that August 2001 the schools will be able to accommodate students. The projects include G.R. Whitfield and Pactolus renovations and the land for the new high school. Ms. Bryan said she would be back in September with bids in hand for the high school.

Commissioner James asked why the Schools had not done anything in the Belvoir School area when they have had the funds for some time. He said the bid has not gone out for the Belvoir school. Commissioner James said they are not alleviating the problems at the Belvoir School. He stated that the Ayden-Grifton High School is going to a 1-A School because they do not have enough students but they are building a high school in the Winterville area. He

asked where they are going to get the students to put in these schools. He said he would vote for the resolution because he knows the schools being considered need it but they need to look at their priorities. Vice Chairman Hammond said he thought they were talking about budgeting for a new high school on Forlines Road. K-5 elementary, land for high school, renovations at Pactolus and GR Whitfield schools.

Ms. Bryan said that the State provided bond funds to Pitt County starting in 1996 which were applied to the needs in the Belvoir School area. They have received funds annually and the Belvoir School was in the last year of the funding. Commissioner Ward said the local School Board made those decisions. She said she understood that the land has been purchased and they are looking at requests for bids now. Vice Chairman Hammond said he would prefer for the high schools not to lose their conference status and had heard that they are looking at busing to overcome this problem.

Ms. Bryan stated the purpose of this resolution was to extend the maturity on the existing short term note until May 2000 to enable it to be paid off through the debt issue. The request is for a ninety (90) day extension on the existing short term debt instrument. She said they are due to let bids in June on the high school. This is a combined project for \$26.5 million including the land.

Vice Chairman Hammond stated that someone from the schools should be present when the Board is discussing school projects.

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners for the County of Pitt, North Carolina, was held in the Commissioners' Auditorium, Pitt County Office Building, Greenville, North Carolina, the regular place of meeting, at 9:00 a.m. on March 13, 2000.

Present: Chairman Charles Gaskins, presiding, and Commissioners Glenn Bowen, Tom Johnson, Sr., Mark W. Owens, Jr., Beth Ward, M. Theresa Shank, David Hammond and Eugene James.

The Chairman of the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of the County of Pitt, North Carolina (the "County") announced that this was the hour and day of the public hearing on the proposed installment financing agreement to be entered into by the County pursuant to Section 160A-20 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, in an amount not to exceed \$23,000,000, for the purpose of financing all or a portion of the cost of (a) acquiring, constructing and equipping a new elementary school, (b) enlarging, expanding and renovating two existing schools and (c) refinancing the previous purchase of land by the County to be used for a new high school, all such property to be located within the County. The site of the new elementary school and the sites of the two existing schools will be conveyed to the County by the Pitt County Board of Education. The County currently owns the site to be used for the new high school. These sites and facilities will be leased to the Pitt County Board of Education for use by the Pitt County Board of Education for school purposes. The lease of such property to the Pitt County Board of Education will be subordinate to the lien created under a deed of trust executed and delivered by the County to secure its obligations under the Agreement.

The Chairman acknowledged due publication of the notice of public hearing in a newspaper with a general circulation in said County as required by Section 160A-20(g) of the General Statutes of North Carolina and directed the Clerk to the Board to attach the affidavit showing publication in said paper on a date at least ten days prior to the date hereof as Exhibit A hereto.

The Chairman then announced that the Board of Commissioners would immediately hear anyone who might wish to be heard on the advisability of the proposed project or financing as so described.

A list of all persons making comments and a summary of such comments are attached as Exhibit B.

The public hearing was closed.

Thereupon, the Chairman announced that this was also the hour and day of the public hearing on the proposed acquisition by the County of certain property for use by the Pitt County Board of Education for school purposes. Such public hearing is being held pursuant to Section 153A-158.1 of the General Statutes of North Carolina. Such property acquisition by the County would be in furtherance of a proposed plan of finance described in the previous public hearing conducted pursuant Section 160A-20(g) of the General Statutes of North Carolina whereby the County would enter into an installment financing agreement for the purpose of financing all or a portion of the cost of (a) acquiring, constructing and equipping a new elementary school, (b) enlarging, expanding and renovating two existing schools and (c) refinancing the previous purchase of land by the County to be used for a new high school, all such property to be located within the County. The site of the new elementary school and the sites of the two existing schools will be conveyed to the County by the Pitt County Board of Education. The County currently owns the site to be used for the new high school. These sites and facilities will be leased to the Pitt County Board of Education for use by the Board of Education for school purposes.

The Chairman acknowledged due publication of the notice of public hearing in a newspaper with a general circulation in the County and directed the Clerk to the Board to attach the affidavit showing publication in said paper on a date at least ten days prior to the date hereof as Exhibit C hereto.

The Chairman then announced that the Board of Commissioners would immediately hear anyone who might wish to be heard on the advisability of the proposed project or financing as so described.

A list of all persons making comments and a summary of such comments are attached as Exhibit D.

The public hearing was closed.

All statements and comments by participants of both public hearings were duly considered by the Board of Commissioners.

Thereupon, Finance Director Melonie Bryan introduced the following resolution the title of which was read and copies of which had been previously distributed to each Commissioner:

**RESOLUTION MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS REGARDING THE FINANCING AND REFINANCING OF SCHOOL PROJECTS PURSUANT TO AN INSTALLMENT FINANCING AGREEMENT AND REQUESTING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMISSION TO APPROVE THE FINANCING ARRANGEMENT**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") for the County of Pitt, North Carolina (the "County") as follows:

Section 1. The Board does hereby find and determine as follows:

(a) There exists in the County a dire need to make various improvements to (a) acquire, construct and equip a new elementary school, (b) enlarge, expand and renovate two existing schools and (c) refinance the previous purchase of land by the County to be used for a new high school, all such property to be located within the County, to enable the County to perform its obligations with respect to the funding of school capital improvements;

(b) After due consideration, the County has determined to enter into an installment financing agreement (the "Agreement") in a principal amount not to exceed \$23,000,000 to pay the cost of to acquiring, constructing and equipping a new elementary school and enlarging, expanding and renovating two existing schools (collectively, the "Project") and to refinance the previous purchase of land by the County to be used for a new high school;

(c) The County will enter into the Agreement with a nonprofit corporation created under the laws of the State of North Carolina and known as the Pitt Regional Infrastructure Development Effort, Inc. (the "Corporation"), pursuant to which Agreement the Corporation will advance to the County amounts sufficient to pay the cost of financing the Project and to

refinance the previous purchase of land, and the County will repay the advancement in installments, with interest (the "Installment Payments");

(d) In order to secure its obligations under the Agreement, the County will execute and deliver a deed of trust (the "Deed of Trust"), granting a lien on the sites upon which the all or a portion of the Project will be located and the site of the new high school, together with all improvements and fixtures thereon;

(e) In order to provide the amount of the advance, the Corporation will enter into a trust agreement (the "Trust Agreement") with First-Citizens Bank & Trust Company (the "Trustee"), pursuant to which the Corporation will execute and deliver certificates of participation evidencing proportionate and undivided interests in the right to receive the Installment Payments;

(f) It is in the best interest of the County to enter into the Agreement and the Deed of Trust in that such transaction will result in providing financing and refinancing for much needed school projects in an efficient and cost effective manner;

(g) Entering into the Agreement is preferable to a general obligation bond and revenue bond issue in that (i) the County does not have sufficient constitutional authority to issue non-voted general obligation bonds pursuant to Article V, Section 4 of the North Carolina Constitution because the County has not retired a sufficient amount of debt in the preceding fiscal year to issue a sufficient amount of general obligation bonds for the Project and the refinancing without an election; (ii) the nature of the facility is such that it is not a "revenue bond project" within the meaning of The State and Local Government Revenue Bond Act; (iii) the cost of the Project and the refinancing exceeds the amount to be prudently provided from currently available appropriations and unappropriated fund balances; (iv) the circumstances existing require that funds be available to commence construction of the Project and to refinance the previous purchase of land as soon as practicable and the time required for holding an election for the issuance of voted general obligation bonds pursuant to Article V, Section 4 of the North Carolina Constitution and the Local Government Bond Act will delay the commencement of construction of the Project and the refinancing of the previous purchase of land by several months; and (v) there can be no assurances that the Project and refinancing will be approved by the voters and the necessity of such Project and refinancing dictates that the Project and refinancing be financed by a method that assures that such Project will be constructed and refinancing will occur in an expedient manner;

(h) An analysis has been prepared comparing the cost of the financing described above against the financing of the Project and the refinancing of the previous purchase of land through the issuance of general obligation bonds of the County, which analysis indicates that the cost of the alternative means of financing compared with the issuance of general obligation bonds is reasonably comparable and acceptable to the Board;

(i) Special counsel to the County will render an opinion to the effect that the proposed undertaking as described above is authorized by law and is a purpose for which public funds may be expended pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of North Carolina;

(j) The debt management policies of the County have been carried out in strict compliance with law, and the County is not in default under any obligation for repayment of borrowed money; and

(k) Any anticipated tax rate increase necessary to pay the Installment Payments is reasonable and not excessive.

Section 2. The Board hereby approves the filing of an application with the Local Government Commission for approval of the Agreement and requests the Local Government Commission to approve of the Agreement and the proposed financing in connection therewith.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

Upon motion of Commissioner Owens, seconded by Commissioner Ward, the foregoing resolution entitled "RESOLUTION MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS REGARDING THE FINANCING AND REFINANCING OF SCHOOL PROJECTS PURSUANT TO AN INSTALLMENT FINANCING AGREEMENT AND REQUESTING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMISSION TO APPROVE THE FINANCING ARRANGEMENT" was passed by the following vote:

## ITEMS FOR REPORT

### Manager's Report – Tom Robinson

Mr. Robinson reported on the following:

Buy-out Program Report- County has submitted applications. The Federal Government has provided a second round of funding. Mr. Rhodes has taken the applications to Raleigh. Mr. Rhodes reported that the February 29<sup>th</sup> deadline for first round of homes were those homes that met the substantial damage criteria. Three packages have been submitted and are being reviewed jointly that include 170 properties with 187 residential structures. He reported the Stokes Road and Old River Road are covered. He reviewed the largest areas included in the buy-out program with the Board. He reviewed several areas including the Sunnyside Road and Contentnea Creek area. He said the staff went to Raleigh last Wednesday and FEMA representatives are in Pitt County reviewing these areas. Only two or three properties have been questioned. He said he hoped to have approval within a couple of weeks. Mr. Robinson stated that the County Attorney is advertising for a paralegal to assist in coordinating the legal process of the buyout. There are supplemental funds in Phase II. The [State Acquisition and Relocation Funds Application requesting approximately \\$4 million was submitted to the State on March 8, 2000. These monies \(also referred to as "gap financing"\) are to be used to assist homeowners involved in the buy-out program in relocating to "comparable" housing which in most cases will cost more than the fair market value they are given for the flood-damaged property.](#) Commissioner James asked about six trailers that were on Penny Hill Road. Mr. Rhodes said that there is a mobile home park in that area that they are working with. This is a voluntary program and they have to come in and sign up. He asked Commissioner James to send them to the Planning Office and they will assist them. Commissioner Bowen asked when the people can move out of the temporary trailer parks. Mr. Rhodes reviewed the actual process including title searches and deed transfers. Appraisals also have to be done on these properties. Mr. Rhodes said that the County's application should be easier to administer once the funds are approved because most of the work that has already been done.

Commissioner James asked about the mobile home site at the Lewis property. Ms. Burgdorff said all the leases have a eighteen month lease term. Commissioner James asked

who would pay the bill after the initial eighteen months. Commissioner James asked if there were still people in motels. Vice Chairman Hammond said Farmville did not have but sixteen homes flooded and it looks like there was inside information when the Pitt County Emergency Services Coordinator's property was already processed. Mr. Rhodes said replacement and repair grants are not available for people who will not leave the flood plains. Properties that are outside the flood plain now have monies available for them. These people need to see the housing counselors. Mr. Robinson stated that the monies are coming through the counties and the County has to administer these payments. It is taking a lot of staff time to deal with this whole program.

The Recovery Operations Center is in full swing and over 900 people visited the center in a one week period. Housing counselors are in the center five days a week.

Mr. Robinson said the State has required the County to establish a Hurricane Floyd Community Task Force. Mr. Bulow reported that the task force would be made up of seven members consisting of; one member from a community-based organization, one member from the non-profit sector; one member from a faith-based organization; one member from the Pitt County Board of Commissioners; two members appointed at large and one Assistant County Manager. Mr. Bulow said the committee would function as any other committee with detailed minutes. He said that he would assist in coordinating the committee and other parties would have input in the plan that they would generate. He said he hoped to make a recommendation for membership at the next meeting. Vice Chairman Hammond asked if there was any way to simplify things for the flood victims. A lot of these people are going to the hospital because of their worry. Mr. Robinson said that they may not be able to simplify things for the people but they are trying to move things along and help the citizens as much as possible. He said it is a very complicated system and the County is struggling with the guidelines that have been established by the State. He said that they are trying to get the State to simplify their process.

- ? NACO Legislative Conference Report - Commissioner Bowen, Commissioner Shank, Vice Chairman Hammond, Mr. Robinson, and JoAnne Burgdorff went to the NACO Conference. He reported on the \$6 billion in damages in North Carolina and have about only \$2 billion coming back to North Carolina. He said it was a major workload. He said they reviewed the Internet Sales tax issue because North Carolina will lose quite a bit of sales tax revenue from internet sales. Census 2000 was a big topic at the NACO Conference. Vice Chairman Hammond said he was disappointed that they did not have anyone from the North Carolina delegation to meet with the Commissioners and staff. Commissioner Shank stated that they visited offices of Senator Helms and Edwards and discussed the possible Internet sales tax loss. She said it was good to connect with other commissioners that had flood damage. North Carolina Commissioners gathered together and discussed what the focus for North Carolina should be at this point in time. She stated she went to a session on welfare reform and went to a seminar about how to collaborate with other groups in the community to help the children.
- ? Census 2000 Kick-off is scheduled for March 16th at 4:00 p.m. at the Wal-mart Store. They have asked the Chairman to attend and have asked the Board to help by doing a resolution to seek a five percent increase in citizens returning of the census forms. Vice Chairman Hammond said he had attended a meeting in the Latino community and they are making a special effort to encourage people to participate in the counting because it will be important for the census and the electoral districts. Mr. Holt stated that there was a 70-76% response in the last census.

**UPON MOTION** by Commissioner Ward, seconded by Vice Chairman Hammond, to approve the resolution of support for the Census 2000 to increase the response by a minimum of

five percent (5%). The Complete Count Committee for Census 2000 has been working on distributing information, handouts, and flyers. Commissioner Shank asked for a list of what the committee has done to date and what they think needs to be done. The motion was unanimously approved.

- 1. Shall encourage every resident, by all means possible, to accurately complete and return their Census 2000 questionnaire; and**
- 2. Shall make every effort to improve Pitt County's Census Questionnaire response rate at least 5% over the 1990 Census response rate; and,**
- 3. Will provide assistance to the Census Bureau work force working in our community; and**
- 4. Shall participate in all joint Census 2000 efforts and programs in conjunction with the governments of Pitt County and local municipalities in promoting Census 2000; and**

### **Report on FEMA Reimbursements – JoAnne Burgdorff**

Ms. Burgdorff stated that Commissioner James had asked her to report on overtime pay and reimbursement from FEMA. She stated that a report was included in the agenda package. The report includes the requests to FEMA but the County has been reimbursed at this time. Attached were the project worksheets. Ms. Bryan informed the Board that there is at least a six weeks turn around on FEMA requests and reimbursements but that she had been assured that the County would be reimbursed on the overtime expenses. She said that she had been told that the County filed their overtime exactly like the State filed their overtime. She said she felt very positive about the reimbursement from FEMA. Vice Chairman Hammond said that he had been told by people high in the FEMA agency that they were not going to pay for overtime. He said he wanted to hear from FEMA that they were going to pay the county for the overtime. He said he talked with Vernon Troller in Atlanta that said they would pay expenses directly related to the disaster. Commissioner James said the money was paid out over four months ago and the County is losing interest on those funds. Commissioner James said he was going to ask the people who were paid that they give the money it back.

### **Update on NC 11 and Northwest Planning Area Projects – James Rhodes**

Mr. Rhodes reported on the NC 11 planning project. They have met eight times including holding public forums. They have drafted documents in place but need a little more review based on the last committee meeting. There are some areas that may need more uses than just residential uses. NC 11 corridor would have some limited uses but primarily the existing uses. Country Mart could go back into the area. The committee unanimously recommended that they go back to the interlocal agreement and discuss clauses dealing with the City of Greenville which allows them to make recommendations. The Councilmember on the committee would like to see more input from the City made as an amendment to the agreement. Mr. Robinson said that the City Council members want a chance to sign off on the agreement. He said that once zoning is in place, it is the County's responsibility for zoning and would not be acceptable for the City of Greenville to have input on this plan. He suggested that this Board send notification back to the City of Greenville that they would not be allowed input in zoning in the County area. Vice Chairman Hammond said that the people have a perception that once the sewer line is built in that area, then they will be annexed into the City of Greenville. Commissioner James said this is not the City's responsibility. Mr. Rhodes said that the decision about the amendment clause would be a request from the City not a County responsibility. Commissioner Shank asked if the Board could just abide by the original Interlocal agreement.

Vice Chairman Hammond **motioned** for the Manager to write a letter to the City of Greenville expressing the County's position to abide by the existing Interlocal agreement. Commissioner Ward seconded motion.

Commissioner Bowen said that he learned at the NACO conference that people were moving away from traditional zoning. He wanted the County to do away with the zoning issue.

The Board discussed the status of zoning and municipalities and the extraterritorial jurisdiction.

Mr. Rhodes reported that the Northwest Area Planning Committee would meet next Wednesday night. He said this is an eleven-member committee with nine landowners and Vice Chairman Hammond serves on this committee. He said they have received comments from the public forum on February 29<sup>th</sup>. They are proceeding on Wednesday to move forward on the zoning proposal in the Northwest area as well. Commissioner James stated that there needs to be planning for the land in this area. He said he believes that there needs to be more organization in development in this area.

Chairman Gaskins called for a break.

Chairman Gaskins called the meeting back to order.

Chairman Gaskins stated that Commissioner Owens had asked to be excused. The Board voted to excuse Commissioner Owens.

**Schedule Workshop on Board Size and at-large districts – JoAnne Burgdorff**

Mr. Robinson introduced the item of scheduling a Board meeting with Mr. Michael Crowell on Board size and at-large districts stating that the Chairman had asked that this be considered by the Board. He stated that Mr. Michael Crowell, Attorney, originally worked with Pitt County on the existing districting. He has indicated that he can be with the County the week of April 10<sup>th</sup> or 24<sup>th</sup> in the Commissioners' Auditorium. Commissioner Bowen asked about the price he would charge to consult with the Board of Commissioners. Commissioner James spoke on Mr. Crowell being an expert on this item.

Commissioner James **motioned** to meet on April 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. with Mr. Crowell and the Board of Commissioners in the Commissioners' Auditorium to discuss with the Board information and options possible changes in Pitt County. Commissioner Shank seconded the motion. Vice Chairman Hammond asked if the Justice Department should be conferred with before meeting with Mr. Crowell. Ms. Burgdorff said the Board could meet to gain information but any request for changes would have to be approved by the United States Justice Department. The motion passed unanimously.

**TMA Tax Audits for Businesses with Personal Property from \$200,000 To \$400,000 – Glenn Cutrell**

Mr. Robinson introduced this item and said that the County may break even on moving down to the next level of discovery on personal property audits for businesses. Commissioner James said since the Manager does not believe the County will generate additional funds then it would put excess work on the Tax Office that may not benefit the County. Mr. Cutrell said there would be funds generated in subsequent years but that this is the last grouping that he would recommend auditing. Mr. Robinson said it is the Tax Office's responsibility to audit these accounts. Commissioner Bowen asked if this process could be done at random by the Tax Office. Mr. Cutrell said it could be done but the process would be slow because of limited staff.

Commissioner James **motioned** to cancel the contract with TMA for tax audits. Vice Chairman Hammond seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**Schedule Board of Equalization and Review Meetings – Glenn Cutrell**

Mr. Cutrell stated that he would like to schedule April 17<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup> for Board of Equalization meetings. The Board discussed holding the meetings earlier that the regular Board meeting so people would not have to wait..

**UPON MOTION** by Vice Chairman Hammond, seconded by Commissioner James, the Board voted unanimously to schedule the Board of Equalization and Review meetings on April 17<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup> at 8:30 a.m. prior to the regular board meetings.

**Budget Amendment for Social Services – Ed Garrison**

- a. Adult Protective Services
- b. Hurricane Floyd – Emergency Benefit Cards

Mr. Garrison discussed some of the process of recovery from the flood on Social Services. He spoke about the electronic benefit cards that the State initiated immediately after the flood. He reviewed the process where they issued food stamp electronic benefit cards which went into effect following the flood. Citibank is now charging the State of North Carolina \$12.56 for each card. The County is responsible for \$6.23 per card for a total of \$41,000 in expenses to Pitt County. He stated that the County needs to apply for a grant to offset the County's cost of this program as soon as possible. He said they are pushing, through the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners, for relief of this expense. Vice Chairman Hammond stated that this fee by Citibank was part of a discussion in Washington, DC at the NACO Legislative Conference. He said it looks like they increased the fees after the cards were initiated. Mr. Garrison said that Citibank has increased their financial standing on the backs of those who suffered during the flood. He said he was inclined to believe that this was just the beginning. Mr. Garrison said State departments are telling the counties that they do not have the money to meet their obligations of the past and he expressed concern about whether the County would received all the funds that have been obligated to Pitt County from the State.

Commissioner James said he would like the Manager to write representatives for Pitt County stating the facts and why the County has no recourse and let them know that Pitt County Commissioners are very dissatisfied for this to happen, especially during the time of this disaster. Commissioner Bowen said that Citibank underbid other businesses in this field years ago and now they have run others out of the business and the counties are dependent on them. Mr. Robinson said there are two issues of concern, which is the fee and the federal mandate to go to the electronic cards. He said that Citibank said that because of the immediate turnaround required on this job, their expenses were higher, following the flood.

Mr. Robinson read the Board a letter which he had already put together to send to Dr. Bruton requesting assistance and re-evaluation of this process by the State. He stated that this is an 162% increase in expenses for this service and urged reopening negotiations with Citibank

Commissioner James restated his **motion** that the Manager and Chairman write Pitt County's representatives in Raleigh noting the Board's concern over the increase in fees for the electronic benefit card service and ask what recourse the counties have to address. Vice Chairman Hammond seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Bowen **motioned** to adopt the budget amendments as presented for Social Services. Commissioner Ward seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

**Renovation of ID Lab at Pitt County Detention Center – Phil Dickerson**

Mr. Dickerson introduced Mr. John Farkas, Architect, who designed the ID lab area . Mr. Dickerson stated that they have found a good use for the jail gymnasium. He said it is ideal for this ID lab. The proposal was bid once and they had to change the proposals. The bids were provided to the Board. The contract was multi-prime with the lowest bidder being from

Goldsboro. He quoted each of the low bidders. He said there are two locations where more building can be done if necessary. He provided a copy of the floor plans for the ID lab. Sheriff Mac Manning stated that he had addressed the Board in September with the need to move the lab out of the holding cell because of the flammable liquids, hazardous materials, and a large amount of firearms that are brought into the jail. Municipalities also turn seized weapons over to the jail for evidence. He said the current facility is completely inadequate. This proposal is for a very secure facility. The jail is the best place to store evidence because of the security. The alternate bid was presented to help with security of officers. Mr. Robinson stated there is an existing fund balance that will not be used on the animal shelter that can be used for this project. Commissioner James said this was originally presented as a \$25,000-\$30,000 project in the old courthouse. Mr. Robinson said they are renovating a much larger area and there is more equipment. There will be evidence rooms, tool storage, fingerprint analysis, dark room, bio-hazardous room which are set up for multiple uses. Commissioner James asked about federal prisoners. Sheriff Manning stated they had 59 federal prisoners today. He said crime is down and so are the numbers of arrests. Mr. Robinson said that since the jail census is down they are trying to close off the pods that they do not need to fill. Commissioner Ward said the only difference she sees in this proposal is that they will be using the existing fund balance that had not been planned for use this year.

Commissioner Bowen asked if any of the space can be rented out by the State.

**UPON MOTION** by Commissioner Ward, seconded by Commissioner Shank, to accept the staff recommendation to award the bids to the low bidders in the total amount of \$553,539 for the new ID lab and new offices; and, to designate the funding source as fund balance. Vice Chairman Hammond asked if the Animal Shelter was being put on hold so the ID lab can be completed. Mr. Robinson said that it is necessary to get this underway in connection with the courthouse renovations. He said that because of the storm, the staff has not been able to move forward on the Animal Shelter on a timely basis. Commissioner James called for the question. The motion was passed unanimously.

**Schedule Open House for Courthouse – Phil Dickerson**

Mr. Dickerson said that the courthouse is complete except for a few furniture items. The seal was broken and they are re-manufacturing a new seal. He said the staff has identified the date of April 28<sup>th</sup> for the courthouse open house. Mr. Robinson said they would like to invite some dignitaries and specific officials for tours and then open up for an open house for the public with guided tours.

Commissioner James **motioned** to start the open house at 1:00 p.m. on April 28<sup>th</sup>. Commissioner Shank seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously.

**Designation of County Manager's Office as Lead Agency for the Administration of the Home and Community Care Block Grant (Aging) and Appointment of a Committee to Develop a funding plan – John Bulow**

Mr. Bulow stated that this grant had been received annually by Pitt County for about ten years. This grant will provide over \$600,000 into Pitt County for the aging population. He said the State has asked for appointment of a committee to develop a funding plan for this grant. Mr. Bulow requested the Board designate the county Manager's Office as lead agency for administration of this grant and appoint the Assistant County Manager, the DSS Director, the council on Aging Director, and the Director of the Creative Living Center as committee members. In addition, he requested the Board appoint Donna Reading, Bill Pearsall, and Jessie McDonald as recommended by Louisa Cox.

Commissioner James **motioned** to designate the County Manager's Office as lead agency and appoint the Assistant County Manager, the DSS Director, the Council on Aging Director, and the Director of the Creative Living Center as committee members and further, to appoint Donna Reading, Bill Pearsall, and Jessie McDonald as at-large members. Commissioner Shank seconded the motion and the motion was approved unanimously.

**Appointment and Reappointment to PCMH Board of Trustees – Susan Banks**

Ms. Banks stated that Ms. Baldree is eligible for reappointment.

Commissioner Bowen said he thought there was a need to have new representation on the PCMH Board of Trustees and offered a nomination of Horace (Robert) Tripp to serve on the PCMH Board of Trustees. Commissioner James **motioned** to accept this nomination by acclamation. Vice Chairman Hammond seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Johnson nominated Bobby Owens for appointment. Commissioner Ward motioned to accept the nomination for Bobby Owens by acclamation. Vice Chairman Hammond seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

**Appointment of Commissioner to Martin Community Action Board – Susan Banks**

This appointment was delayed during approval of the agenda.

**Tar River Bridge Crossing Resolution**

Mr. Robinson stated that Collice Moore, Board member on the North Carolina Department of Transportation was pursuing funding for a feasibility study for a reliable raised crossing of the Tar River. so Pitt County would never be cut off or cut in half like it was during the Hurricane Floyd flooding.

**UPON MOTION** by Vice Chairman Hammond, seconded by Commissioner James, the Board voted unanimously to approve the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF ROADWAY SYSTEM  
NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE TAR RIVER FOR CASES OF FLOODS OR OTHER  
NATURAL DISASTERS IN PITT COUNTY**

WHEREAS, an adequate transportation system is critical to the conducting of business and commerce and for providing access to health care facilities in Pitt County; and

WHEREAS, the Pitt County Board of County Commissioners finds it difficult to conduct business or transport supplies and persons north and south of the Tar River in the event of a flood or natural disaster such as Hurricane Floyd; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the safety and economy of Pitt County to have a feasibility study conducted which would identify the most efficient and effective roadway system that provides that ability to transport goods and persons from one side of the Tar River to the other in the event of flood or other natural disasters;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Pitt County Board of County Commissioners that it supports a feasibility study being conducted for purposes of identifying a roadway system for the transport of goods and persons from the north to the south side of the Tar River in Pitt County, and what is needed to achieve that system, in the event of flood or other natural disasters.

## **ITEM FOR DISCUSSION**

### **Demolishing Structures Damaged by Floyd – Phil Dickerson**

Mr. Dickerson stated that they have demolished some of the structures damaged in the flood but they have structures where they cannot find an owner that need to be demolished. He said there may be a time where these structures are falling down but an owner may not want the structure demolished. He asked for direction from the Board. Vice Chairman Hammond said the County needs to be cleaned up. If they are vacated and rotting, then they need to be demolished.

Vice Chairman Hammond **motioned** to give authorization to staff to aggressively proceed with the demolition of structures that meet the criteria for demolishing structures. Commissioner James seconded the motion. Commissioner Shank asked about the cost involved. Mr. Dickerson said that at the moment, the cost would be covered by FEMA. March 15<sup>th</sup> is still the deadline for this program. Commissioner Bowen said if the properties are condemned, then the landowner can be charged. Ms. Burgdorff said that the County can charge the landowner but the likelihood of recovering those costs from the landowners are slim. She said they have done title searches for owners, published them in the newspaper, and done what they were legally bound to do. The motion was unanimously approved. Mr. Dickerson asked about abandoned homes. He said there is going to come a time when the County sees the necessity for demolition but the landowner will not agree and he needed to know that he had the Board's support.

## **COMMISSIONER REPORTS AND COMMENTS**

Commissioner Bowen said he would like to see something done about teenage pregnancy in this County. Five girls that are thirteen years old in Ayden-Grifton High School are pregnant and something needs to be done to prevent this situation.

Vice Chairman Hammond commended the Manager for all of his efforts in trying to secure more funding for the disaster relief and recovery and his presentations at the NACO Legislative Conference in Washington, DC.

**CLOSED SESSION – G.S. 143-318.11(a)(1) and (6)**

**UPON MOTION** by Commissioner Ward, seconded by Commissioner James, the Board voted unanimously to go into closed session following the County Attorney citing the following General Statutes:

(1) Personnel – to consider qualifications, competence, performance, condition of appointment of a public officer or employee or prospective public officer or employee; and, (6) Approval of (2) Closed Session Minutes – prevent the disclosure of privilege information - Closed Session Minutes from November 1, 1999, November 15, 1999, December 6, 1999, December 13, 1999, December 20, 1999, January 24, 2000 and February 7, 2000.

**UPON MOTION** by Commissioner Bowen, seconded by Commissioner James, the Board voted unanimously to return to open session.

**UPON MOTION** by Commissioner Ward, seconded by Commissioner James, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 1:10 p.m.
