CALL TO ORDER – Chairman Gaskins

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE

The Invocation was provided by Vice Chairman Hammond.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Johnson.

Chairman welcomed everyone in attendance.

Mr. Robinson noted that Commissioner Huggins was not present.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner James, seconded by Vice Chairman Hammond, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the April 11, 2000, April 17, 2000 and May 1, 2000 Board meetings.

Vice Chairman Hammond moved to excuse Commissioner Huggins from the Board meeting. Vice Chairman Hammond withdrew the motion.

Commissioner Huggins arrived at this time.

PUBLIC ADDRESSES TO THE BOARD

- Bob Ramey - Thanked the Board for their service and stated that he recognized the hardship it is on the commissioners that work full-time and serve as commissioners. He praised Mr. Robinson for his service and decision-making. Thanked Ms. Burgdorff for her service also. He thanked the Board as a citizen of the County. Especially thanked Chairman Gaskins for his years of service.
- Keith Cooper - Congratulated Bishop Randy B. Royal for his victory in the county commissioner election and also thanked Commissioner Huggins for her outstanding representation of the county. He stated he was happy to retain a black on this Board. He said it is ridiculous that there are only two black commissioners. He spoke on Senior Citizens Week and indicated that the life expectancy of this age group is increasing. He said the Board has not done anything regarding Senior Citizens Week and requested a line item entry in the budget for such an occasion. The Town of Ayden did something to acknowledge Senior Citizens and hopes the County will do the same next year.

Mr. Robinson stated that Mr. Morrison has requested to speak but did not sign up on the sign up sheet.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner Bowen, seconded by Commissioner James, the Board voted unanimously to allow Mr. Vernon Morrison to speak.

- Vernon Morrison - stated he should be invited to speak and not have to sign up for same. He indicated that he felt it unnecessary to have to sign up on such a sheet and was very provoked by it. He commented on the Trade Stations and the gas prices in general. He said that the Board should consider censorship on travel.

Mr. Robinson moved on to the Legislative Goals item and will come back to the Strive Program item because the meeting was ahead of schedule and Joyce Jones was not yet present.

Legislative Goals – JoAnne Burgdorff

Ms. Burgdorff stated that she had been told by members of our delegation that only matters that were not controversial and no tax funding needed would be considered as legislative goals. Presently, Pitt County's legislative goals did not fall in this category. It was indicated to her that it would be a very short legislative session and she was instructed to save our goals until the next long session. Mr. Robinson said he agreed with Ms. Burgdorff and stated that there are other counties that are pursuing a local option sales tax. If these other counties can get their requests through, he would like a motion to piggyback on their legislation. Commissioner Ward said that when the Board goes to Raleigh for the Legislative Update, they should discuss what will be pursued in the fall and still supply some goals. Commissioner Ward motioned for the Board to come up with a legislative package to take to the Legislative Goals conference. Commissioner Shank seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner James said the County is going to have to come up with a lot of money for the Education Compact and agreed that the Legislators need to be contacted and presented with Pitt County's goals and needs.

Report on Strive Program – Joyce Jones, Executive Director for Life of NC , John Chaffee, Margaret Dixon

Mr. Robinson said this program helps provide job skills primarily for minorities so they can gain financial independence. Ms. Jones stated they are a newly formed nonprofit program.

The goals and objectives for this program were aired on "60 Minutes" approximately two years ago. She indicated that they needed community support. The chairman of this Board is John Chaffee with the Industrial Development Commission. Employers have indicated that they have problems with keeping employees because of attitudes, absences and other problems. She reported on partners in this program.

She has brought this before the Board today to ask for their support. Presently, this program is being funded by Z. Smith Reynolds Foundation and several other grants. Currently, they are housed in the Rubbermaid plant until they can find suitable accommodations. She provided a video that explained the program. Current Board members Jessie Harris and Margaret Dixon were present also.

Commissioner Bowen asked what the relationship was between STRIVE and LIFE. Ms. Jones commented that LIFE is a non-profit organization. STRIVE does not receive government funding and has no strings attached. The Department of Labor has asked Strive to contract with them because of their job retention rate. They have recently begun to enter into contracts with other government agencies and that Pitt County is the first rural program of this nature. Commissioner Huggins commended Ms. Jones, board members and staff on their efforts.

UPON MOTION by Vice Chairman Hammond, seconded by Commissioner Ward, the Board voted to endorse the STRIVE program and unanimously to approve the motion.

Commissioner Bowen asked about the current budget. Ms. Jones responded that there is no cost to the client and the program costs approximately \$1,500 per week to operate. The Z. Smith Reynolds grant and the Poverty Board are currently funding the program. Commissioner Ward asked how they obtain their clients. Ms. Jones stated they are receiving referrals from Department of Social Services, Vocational Rehabilitation and the Probation/Parole office. They operate on a three week cycle that will be run each month. John Chaffee commented that he feels this program will do a good service to the industrial citizens and the employers in Pitt County. It will be a resource that provides good quality labor which is a major objective of industries. They hope to develop a good program that will provide for industrial clients.

Update on Hurricane Related Housing Assistance Programs – Susan Jenkins, Redevelopment Manager, NC Department of Commerce

Ms. Jenkins indicated that she is currently covering six counties for related housing assistance programs. However, Pitt County has received the most devastation as a result of Hurricane Floyd. She currently has an office at the Pitt County Recovery Operations Center and is there one day a week. She has been employed as of May 10, 2000. Gene Byrd is concerned about the problems Pitt County is experiencing and has scheduled a meeting to discuss this issue this week. She said she wants to help get people back on their feet. Commissioner Bowen asked if she was in charge of the housing counselors because he and Commissioner James have received complaints. She said she has been working on the process to develop a new system and hopes to have results by Monday.

Mr. Rhodes said that this coincides with the repair grant that has been submitted. Individuals have to be seen by the housing counselors and those that are eligible will be targeted by the end of this week. This assistance is for people who did not qualify for the buy-out program. Presently, they have 160 potential applicants and \$6.5 million in requests. One structure in Pitt County has been approved for replacing the household structure but there have been no further awards since February. The state is still swapping properties and this has been forwarded to FEMA. Contracts for surveyors and appraisers are being worked out and they hope to have them available for the first meeting with the people in the Buy-out Program. Only \$4 million has been funded but is on standby until the County receives the remainder of the federal government funding. The first week of June Ms. Jenkins will personally start working in Pitt County Recovery Operations Center.

Juvenile Crime Prevention Council 2000-2001 Budget Approval – Brian Stewart, Chair

Mr. Brian Stewart, Chairman of Juvenile Crime Prevention Council presented the 2000-2001 Budget. Pitt County's state allocation is Three thousand thirty six hundred fifty eight dollars. Five programs for funding are recommended plus JCPC certification for a total of \$217,266. The balance of available JCPC funds to be budgeted later, is one hundred and nineteen thousand, three hundred ninety two dollars. UPON MOTION by Commissioner James , seconded by Commissioner Ward for approval of the Juvenile Crime Prevention Council 2000-2001 Budget as presented to the Board. The Board voted unanimously to approve the motion.

Vice Chairman Hammond asked Commissioner Ward about her participation in this committee. Commissioner Ward said that she has not attended all regular meetings but has served on a subcommittee that met well beyond the committee meetings. She said she was amazed at how many programs there are in Pitt County that help the youth. She said she was very impressed with the programs that they fund.

Application for Certified Industrial Site status for Farmville Corporate Park from GTP – John Chaffee

The Development Commission is applying for Certified Industrial site status for Farmville Corporate Park from the Global Transpark. The CIS status is a statewide certification process that signifies to prospective industries and economic development professionals that the park is a superior site for industrial development. All costs associated with the application will be reimbursed to the Development Commission by a \$50,000 grant from Global Transpark.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner Owens, seconded by Commissioner Ward, the Board unanimously voted to endorse this application.

Extension of the Proclamation in Response to A County State of Emergency entered on November 15, 1999 – JoAnne Burgdorff

Ms. Burgdorff stated that this snagging project has taken much more time than originally anticipated making this extension necessary. She anticipates that this will be completed by next fall.

UPON MOTION by Commissioner James, seconded by Commissioner Huggins, the Board voted unanimously to approve this extension of this resolution.

Review of Education Compact and schedule joint meeting – Tom Robinson

Mr. Robinson stated the committee met and developed an Education Compact which outlines goals for the Board of Commissioners and the Board of Education. The compact helps maintain that everyone stays in agreement. This means an increase in funding by the Board of Commissioners by approximately \$2.4 million in the upcoming budget year. This can be attained with interest earnings. It may take four years to maintain such funding. The funds are budgeted for this year with no tax increase this year but it will be a stretch over the upcoming years. The Board indicated that education was their highest priority and that this is a joint effort to achieve this goal. There was a recommendation from the committee for approval by both Boards. Commissioner Shank, Commissioner Ward, and Vice Chairman Hammond have served on this committee. Commissioner Ward said that during the first meeting of the Education Compact Committee they tried to determine the goals for the next five years. As a top priority, they needed to figure out how to attain funding for this five year span. The Education Compact demonstrates a joint venture of the Board of Education and the Board of Commissioners and becomes an official contract. They are in total compliance with what the State is expecting with some of the goals being higher than what the State actually expects. Commissioner Ward hopes that Pitt County will achieve ranking in the top one-third in the State for education. Vice Chairman Hammond said it was very important that the two boards work together and maintain improved communications. He stated that we must keep in mind that Pitt County is classified as a low wealth county. He noted that Ephraim Smith who is on the Board of Education was present in the audience. They agreed that the two boards should get together and celebrate this achievement. Commissioner Shank stated that it was wonderful that the two boards are on the

same page and that it will improve the economic impact and quality of life in the community. She said the children will benefit the most from this compact.

Commissioner James said the goals are good but the amount \$2.4 million dollars demands results from the Board of Education as well as the students in Pitt County. He said he supports this plan but that there needs to be drastic changes in the first, second, third and fourth grades. Mr. Robinson said the goals identified by the Board of Education could be measured. They wanted to see good faith efforts for them to achieve their goals.

UPON MOTION by Vice Chairman Hammond, seconded by Commissioner Ward to approve the Education Compact as presented.

Commissioner Bowen asked what this compact has to do with getting more students in Ayden-Grifton High School. He said he wants the same education for every student in Pitt County. Commissioner Huggins said that she is happy to see that the two boards are talking and have measurable goals and will endorse the compact. Commissioner Owens said he is glad to see this come to fruition.

Mr. Ephraim Smith commented he had served on the committee and that the compact assured that there will be funding for the school system in future years. This is a new day for working together with the Board of Commissioners. He said he agreed with the early intervention that more remediation work is needed. Commissioner James asked about Ayden-Grifton and why something can not been done for this school.

The Board voted unanimously to approve the Education Compact unanimously.

Mr. Robinson suggested a meeting for a "State of Pitt County School System" presentation and to celebrate the successes and cooperation. He asked for dates for a joint meeting. Commissioner Shank suggested waiting until after the budget sessions are completed. Mr. Robinson will bring dates back to the Board.

Project Ordinance – Melonie Bryan

Ms. Bryan stated that this project ordinance was to authorize spending accounts for the G.R. Whitfield and Pactolus Elementary Schools, to acquire land for future school development and pay costs related to the issuance of public debt. The project ordinance establishes the accounting for the debt issue and allows the County and the Board of Education to fund the projects.

Section 2. The officers of this unit are hereby authorized to proceed within the terms of this resolution and the budget contained herein.

Section 3. The following revenues are hereby appropriated for the projects listed above:
