The Pitt County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on **Dec. 7 at or after 9:00a** regarding a request for a Conditional Use Permit. This hearing will be held in the 2nd floor Commissioners' Aud. in the County Administration Building, 1717 W. 5th St., Greenville.

The Pitt County Planning Department is in receipt of a petition from **Robert L. Humbles Jr.** requesting a Conditional Use Permit as required in the Rural Agricultural district to allow an expansion to an existing salvage yard on his property. The subject property is identified by the Tax Assessor's Office as Parcel Number 35853. The proposed are for expansion is located on the southern side of SR 1725 (County Home Road), east of its intersection with SR 1923 (Gardnerville Road). Citizens interested in obtaining additional information on this Conditional Use Permit request should call Pitt County Planning.

Cooking Oil Collection containers are located at the Transfer Station off Allen Road and the Bells Fork Collection Site located on County Home Road.

The Pitt County Office of North Carolina Cooperative Extension has started a Kitchen Waste Composting Program. Coffee grounds, eggshells, fruit and vegetable scraps, napkins, paper towels, and tea bags are being collected from the Cooperative Extension office and added to non-woody yard waste to complement the composting program at the Pitt County Agricultural Center and Pitt County Arboretum. The composting demonstration area is open to visitors daily at the Pitt County Agricultural Center and includes instructional signs.
