The MAT reviewed and accepted the July 17 meeting minutes.

Paulette revised the economic costs section of the Plan. The goals, outcomes and strategies, economic costs and the implementation plan will be distributed to public officials in preparation for the August 4 meeting with the County Commissioners and the August 11 meeting with the City of Greenville. Ruth, Bob and Reverend Shuler will each have a role in the presentations made to public officials. The Management Advisory Team will be available to respond to questions asked by public officials.

Ruth identified the sections of the plan that still need revising. The plan will be distributed to the general public during the first week in August. The MAT will continue to make revisions through the end of August.

Ruth provided the first draft of the Power Point presentation to public officials. Ruth will revise the presentation so that it is only 10 minutes. A Power Point presentation will not be required for the Grimesland meeting to be held on August 12. A handout will be sufficient.

The schedule of municipal meetings was presented. The meeting with Farmville public officials will be held on August 4 and meeting dates Ayden, Bethel, Winterville Grifton will be confirmed.

Two presenters will be needed at each presentation to the municipalities. Members of the MAT will be asked to assist with making presentations.
