

**CONSENT TO APPLICATION OF COUNTY STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION
WITHIN Town of Grimesland**

WHEREAS

1. Proclamations of Emergency Restrictions for Pitt County, North Carolina by Chairman Melvin C. McLawhorn, Pitt County Board of Commissioners was signed on March 23, 2020
2. A Second proclamations of Emergency Restrictions for Pitt County, North Carolina was signed by Melvin C. McLawhorn, Chairman of Pitt County Board of Commissioners on March 23, 2020

Be it resolved the Town of Grimesland Board members adopted the Proclamation here to for referenced. Copies which is hereto attached to these documents.

WHEREAS, as a result of the above-described emergency I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property; and

WHEREAS, the County of *Pitt* has declared a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the *Town of Grimesland* is located within the County.


NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Mayor Eleanor Farr of the Town of Grimesland under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter of the Town of Grimesland Code of Ordinances:

Section 1. Pursuant to G.S. 166A-19.22(b)(2), the state of emergency declaration issued by Pitt County shall apply within the corporate limits of the Town of Grimesland.

Section 2. Emergency restrictions and prohibitions imposed pursuant to the County's state of emergency declaration shall apply with the *Town of Grimesland* unless otherwise declared by an authorized municipal official on behalf of the *Town of Grimesland*.

Section 3. The application of the County's state of emergency declaration within the corporate limits of the *Town of Grimesland* shall remain in effect until further notice.
