### Animal Shelter Renovation Project Update

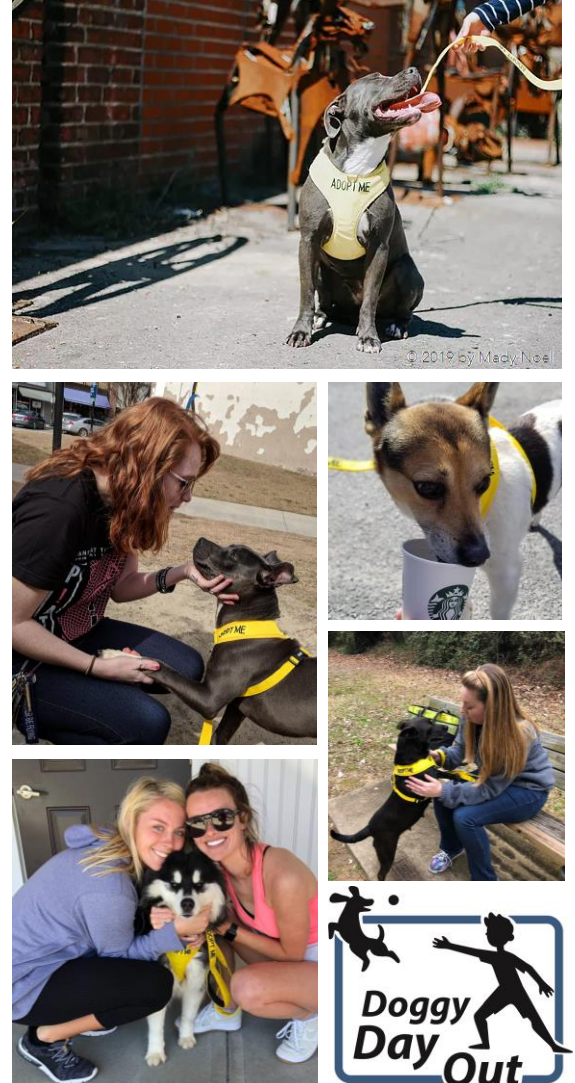
