


Do You Comply With Pitt County's Addressing Ordinance?

Pitt County's Addressing Ordinance requires all addressable structures to have the correct E-911 Address displayed on the structure. If the address cannot be easily read from the road at all times of the year, the number must be displayed at the intersection of the named road and the driveway leading to the structure. Address numbers should be no less than 4 Inches in height and contrast with the background. Address numbers will be available at the Pitt County Planning Department.

Failure To Comply Will Result In Civil Penalties!

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a civil penalty of **\$50.00 per day** after notice of violation.
