Report: Voter history has been completed and balances with votes cast. Three voters attempted to vote twice appearing on Election Day after having already voted via absentee by mail or One-Stop. The provisionals are not approved for counting and the voters' information has been submitted to the NC State Board of Elections for investigation.

Provisional Ballots: Provisional ballot research and findings were presented to the Board. Eight provisionals had been fed by voters into the precincts' DS200 voting machine. The Board accepted staffs' recommendation for the provisional ballots – 418 approved (415 to be counted), 113 partially approved (110 to be counted), and 240 not approved. Envelopes for approved provisionals were opened and ballots fed into the DS200 voting machine. The Board and four Election Assistants (bipartisan team) duplicated the 110 partially approved provisional ballots to omit contests the voter was ineligible to participate in; those ballots were also fed into the DS200 voting machine.

Absentee Ballots:

- a. **Supplemental absentee ballots:** The Board approved 309 supplemental absentee ballots that were timely received that included seventeen UOCAVA ballots that required duplication. All ballots were counted via the DS200 voting machine.
- b. **Supplemental absentee abstract and oaths:** The supplemental absentee abstract and oaths were signed.
