

TATTOOING PERMIT APPLICATION

Pitt County Environmental Health

The North Carolina Rules Governing Tattooing (15A NCAC 18A .3200) and General Statutes 130A-283 require that all tattoo artists register with their local health department (Pitt County Environmental Health) and obtain a permit (via inspection) before engaging in tattooing in said county. The following information is required prior to scheduling the permit inspection:

Application Requirements:

- ✓ All fields shall be completed in full.
- ✓ Permits are issued to an individual at a specific location. Each tattoo artist must complete and sign a separate application for each location where he or she will engage in tattooing within the State of North Carolina. Permits are non-transferable to a different location or person.
- ✓ Applications shall be submitted **30 days** prior to anticipated date to begin tattooing or current permit expiration date.
