


USING YOUR COUNTY'S CONVENIENCE DROP-OFF SITES

Designed for residents of Pitt County, this easy reference guide on the county's waste and recycling services tells how to properly prepare your recyclables and dispose of other special wastes.

Pitt County operates and maintains staffed convenience drop-off sites listed on the back of this brochure. These convenience drop-off sites are for residential waste and recycling only. All commercial and business waste generators must contract with a private waste hauler or take waste directly to the Transfer Station. For more information, visit:

- ⊗ Aerosol cans
- ⊗ All batteries (car, lithium, etc.)
- ⊗ Ceramic items
- ⊗ Clothing or textiles
- ⊗ Diapers
- ⊗ Disposable cups (plastic and paper)
- ⊗ Electronics
- ⊗ Food-tainted items
- ⊗ Glass bottles and jars
- ⊗ Hazardous waste
- ⊗ Household glass (windows, mirrors, glass dishware and Pyrex)
- ⊗ Medical waste
- ⊗ Plastic bags/wrap
- ⊗ Scrap metal/wood
- ⊗ Styrofoam/peanuts
- ⊗ Tanglers (cords, hoses, wires, etc.)
- ⊗ Tires
- ⊗ Toys



ALSO ACCEPTED

The following materials also are accepted for recycling and proper disposal at the county convenience drop-off sites and Transfer Station. For additional restrictions, see the site attendant or visit the website.



Used cooking oil (site 3 and Transfer Station only)



Used motor oil, filters, car batteries



Bulk items (furniture, chairs, etc.)



Large appliances (fridges, washing machines, etc.)



Electronics (computers, TV's, etc.)



Leaves, pine straw, brush, grass, small tree limbs



Clothing and textiles, shoes and prescription eyeglasses



Household trash

In addition, the Transfer Station also accepts thermostats, tires, anti-freeze, construction and demolition (concrete/brick, pallets, shingles, etc.) and latex paint.
